When you recruit a Port Police Officer, you get \$1,000!

Who May Participate as a Recruiter?

All active City of Los Angeles employees are eligible to participate as a Port Police Officer Recruiter. Candidates may not recruit themselves, and the recruiter may not be involved in the recruitment, screening, testing, and/or selection process of candidates for general city of Los Angeles employment or law enforcement employment.

Here are the steps:

- Recruit a candidate who becomes a Port Police Officer.
- Submit a completed Recruitment Referral Form as directed on the form. To download the Recruitment Referral Form, go to www.portoflosangeles.org/about_portpolice.htm#recruit. Both the recruiter and the candidate must sign the Recruitment Referral Form. It is the recruiter's responsibility to submit the Recruitment Referral Form.
- The form must be submitted no later than 30 days after the candidate takes the physical abilities test for the first time.

Important Details

- Candidates may not have entered the selection process prior to April 2007.
- Only one recruitment incentive payment per candidate.
- The recruitment incentive payment will be processed after the recruited candidate successfully obtains an appointment and completes a 30-day assignment at the Police Academy.
- Payment will not be made if all conditions are not met.
- The incentive payment is taxable income.

Port Police Officer Minimum Requirements

- Candidates must be at least 20½ years of age on the written test date.
- Candidate must have a high school diploma or G.E.D.
- Candidates must have a valid, government-issued identification.
- Candidates must be a U.S. Citizen or have applied for citizenship.
