WHEREAS, on September 28, 2005, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners adopted Resolution 6385, which requires advance approval by the Board of Harbor Commissioners where feasible for all Commissioner travel for which reimbursement is requested, and

WHEREAS, Commissioner David Arian has been invited to participate in the Cornell University Global Labor Institute Climate Forum at the Pocantico Conference Center in Tarrytown, New York, and

WHEREAS, topics to be discussed at the forum include AB 32, The California Global Warming Solution Act of 2006, and Curbing Global Emissions from Shipping and Aviation, and

WHEREAS, prior to attending the conference, Commissioner Arian will visit Norfolk, Virginia to tour the Norfolk International Terminal, a 646-acre terminal with five berths and 14 container cranes, and

WHEREAS, while in Norfolk, Commissioner Arian will tour the USS Wisconsin, an Iowa-class battleship now on public display at Norfolk's Nautica Museum, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the trip is approximately \$2,000.00,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the travel of Commissioner David Arian to Norfolk, Virginia and Tarrytown, New York on July 11-15, 2011 is approved.
