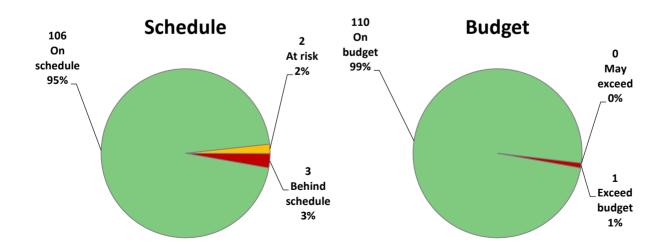

The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 124 Capital projects representing over \$1.7 Billion in total project value. 13 projects are currently on hold leaving 111 active projects. From a budget perspective, 110 projects, or roughly 99% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.



The 5 projects that are either behind schedule or at risk of falling behind schedule include:

- 1) Knoll Drive Lighting project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule.
- 2) New Fiber Optic Line Port of Los Angeles Harbor Administration Building to 110 Freeway On/Off Ramp project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule
- 3) B. 195-199 WWL Terminal Alternative Maritime Power project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
- 4) POLA Electric Vehicle Charging Stations Phase 1 project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
- 5) B. 161 Marine Ways Gate Modification project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule.

The 1 project that is either over budget or at risk of being over budget include:

1) B. 161 - Marine Ways Gate Modification project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the budget.
