Pursuant to the California Coastal Act of 1976 as amended and the Port of Los Angeles' certified Port Master Plan, notice is hereby given to all interested persons and organizations that the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners will hold a public hearing to receive public comments prior to considering a Coastal Development Permit for:

**PORT OF LOS ANGELES – THE BERTHS 238-239 PBF ENERGY MARINE OIL  
TERMINAL WHARF IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

In accordance with Section 6.0 Development Guidelines of the Port Master Plan, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on this proposed project during a special Board meeting on March 21, 2019 at the **Cruise Terminal Baggage Handling Facility** at 250 S. Harbor Blvd., San Pedro, CA 90731 (gray dome adjacent to the Battleship IOWA). The meeting will start no earlier than 11:30 a.m. after the close of an earlier public hearing.

Any person unable to attend the public hearing may submit written comments to the Director of Planning and Strategy, P.O. Box 151, San Pedro, CA 90733. Written comments should be submitted no later than the day before the scheduled public hearing date.
