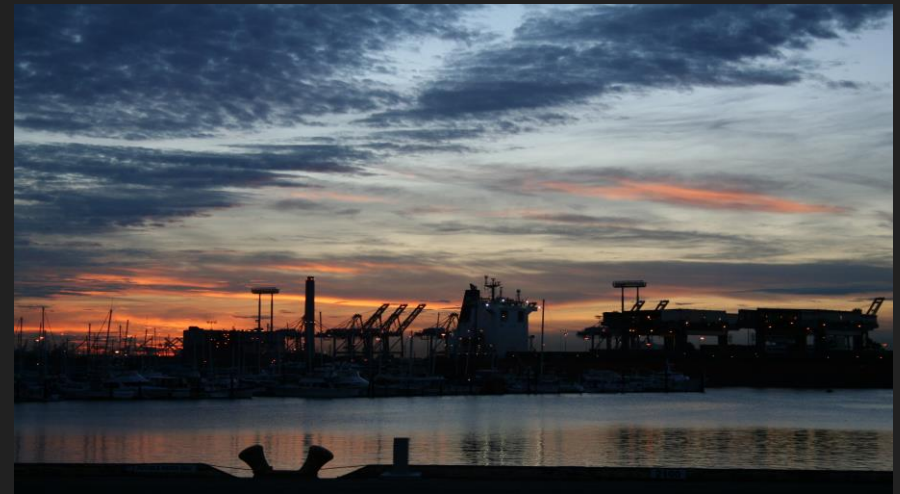
# Partnership with CA State Parks Boating and Waterways



- **Established 2009**
- **Partner with 6 local law enforcement agencies**
- **Nation's first maritime law enforcement training center on West Coast**
- **The only State of CA Police Officers Standards and Training certified and federal recognized training on the West Coast**
- **Initially funded by state and federal grants**
- **Continued funding provided by combination of student tuition, grant funds, and in-kind support from partnering agencies**
- **Specifically designed to train state and local law enforcement, including Los Angeles Port Police Officers**
- **Certified instructors used from partnering agencies and Los Angeles Port Police Officers**
