## LEVEL I COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT REPORT

**DATE: FEBRUARY 13, 2018**

**TO: HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF HARBOR  
COMMISSIONERS**

### BACKGROUND

In accordance with the approved Port of Los Angeles Master Plan (PMP), the Executive Director is designated with the authority to approve or deny applications for Level I Coastal Development Permits (CDP), but these CDPs only become effective when the permits are reported in writing to the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board). No Board action is required. Additionally, the PMP provides that a Level I CDP that is being reported to the Board can be stayed if any two Board members so request. In this case, the CDP would be agendized for the next regular Board meeting and would require Board action to be approved or denied.

### PERMIT ACTIONS

The Executive Director has approved one Level I CDP:

CDP No. 18-04 Port of Los Angeles – Port Police to Install Concrete Structure

The project location for the approved CDP is identified on the attached map (Transmittal 1).

#### **CDP No. 18-04 Port of Los Angeles – Port Police to Install Concrete Structure**

CDP No. 18-04 (Transmittal 2) allows for the installation of a 384 square-foot pre-fabricated concrete structure as outlined in the Application for Port Permit (APP) No. 180122-008. The structure will house the new communications equipment located in the parking lot of the Maritime Law Enforcement training facility. The structure will be placed immediately adjacent to the existing communications tower.

The Environmental Management Division has completed an Environmental Assessment Exemption to assess the potential environmental impacts of the proposed concrete structure installation.

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SUBJECT: LEVEL I CDP REPORT

The estimated project cost is \$600,000 and will be paid by The City of Los Angeles Harbor Department Port Police Division.
