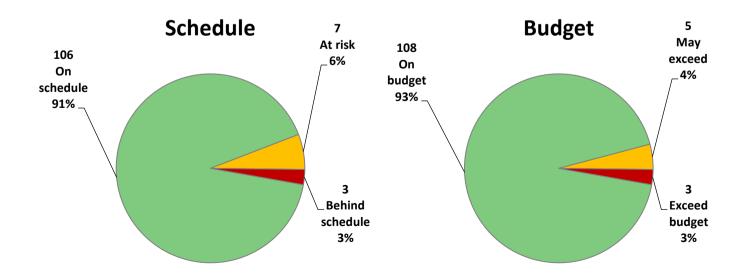

The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 131 Capital projects representing just over \$1 Billion in total project value. 15 projects are currently on hold leaving 116 active projects. From a budget perspective, 108 projects, or roughly 93% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.



The 8 projects that are either over budget or at risk of being over budget include:

1) The Pier 400 Corridor Storage Track Expansion project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget (07-20);

2) The Berth 200 Roadway Extension project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget (07-20);

3) The San Pedro Waterfront - Town Square Public Restrooms project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the budget;

4) The Wilmington Youth Sailing and Aquatic Center project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget (07-20).

5) The Harbor Administration Bldg - Board Hearing Room and Executive Session Room Remodel is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget;

6) The Berth 161 Floating Dock Replacement project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget;

7) The 1050 Ways Street (Starkist) Demolition and Storage Lot Conversion project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget;

8) The Berth 54-55 - Building Cover Replacment project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget.

The 10 projects that are behind schedule or at risk of falling behind schedule include:

1) The Berths 218-220 Landside Stowage Pin Replacement project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

2) The Berth 302-305 Crane Switchgear Modernization project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

3) The Berth 200 Roadway Extension project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule;

4) The San Pedro Waterfront-34.5KV Electrical Utility Service project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

5) The Wilmington Youth Sailing and Aquatic Center project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

6) The Harbor Administration Bldg - Board Hearing Room and Executive Session Room Remodel is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

7) The Fleet Management System project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule (09-20);

8) The Berth 68-Port Pilot Station HVAC Upgrade project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule;

9) The Berth 161-Floating Dock Replacement project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule;

10) The 1050 Ways Street (Starkist) Demolition and Storage Lot Conversion project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (11-20).
