SR 47 INTERCHANGE PROJECT

NIGHTTIME CLOSURE AND LANE REDUCTION OF NORTHBOUND I-110 ON-RAMP



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WHAT:

Crews will reduce the northbound I-110 on-ramp from Harbor Boulevard/Front Street to a single lane for approximately one year. This lane reduction is necessary to perform work to realign the on-ramp as part of the SR 47 Interchange Project.

In order to facilitate the lane reduction, crews will fully close the northbound I-110 on-ramp during nighttime hours for up to one week to restripe lanes and place k-rail at this location.

WHEN:

ON-RAMP NIGHTTIME FULL CLOSURE: 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 24 to Tuesday, June 25, 2024.

ON-RAMP LANE REDUCTION: Monday, June 24, 2024, for approximately one year

ON-RAMP CLOSURE DETOURS:

- A) TRAVELING NORTH ON FRONT STREET:
 - o Continue north on Front Street
 - o Turn right on Pacific Avenue
 - Turn left on northbound I-110 on-ramp at John S. Gibson Blvd. to access the freeway
- B) TRAVELING SOUTH ON HARBOR BOULEVARD
 - Continue south on Harbor Boulevard
 - Turn right on 1st Street
 - Turn right on Gaffey Street
 - Turn right on northbound I-110 on-ramp to access the freeway

The SR 47 Interchange Project will replace the existing southbound SR 47 off-ramp from the Vincent Thomas Bridge, currently on the south side, with a new off-ramp on the north side. Additional improvements include realigning the existing on-ramp to the northbound I-110 connector; modifying the northbound SR 47 off-ramp onto Harbor Boulevard; modifying the northbound SR 47 on-ramp onto the bridge toward Terminal Island; and improving local streets near the interchange.
