The aforementioned Request For Proposals (RFP) has been amended as described below.

The following language has been **added** to RFP Section 1.1, “Brief Overview of the Project”:

The prime Consultant and subconsultants must be businesses organized under the laws of the United States and majority owned or controlled by U.S. citizens or U.S.-based entities. The prime Consultant, subconsultants, and all personnel assigned to perform project services will be located in the United States. All project-facing roles, including but not limited to program management, system architecture, stakeholder engagement, configuration, integration, training, and operational support, will be performed by personnel working within the United States. This requirement applies to all individuals directly performing services under the contract or interacting with Harbor Department staff, systems, or project data.
