- 1. Terms defined in Permit No. 899 ("Permit") shall have the same meanings herein. References herein to "Sections" shall be to sections of the Permit, unless otherwise stated.
 - 2. Section 2.2, Term, is removed entirely and replaced with the following:
- **"2.2 Term.** The term of this Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and shall continue until it expires forty-five (45) years from the Effective Date on May 24, 2057 ("Expiration Date"), unless sooner terminated in accordance with Section 9."
- 3. Section 2.3, Extension Option, is removed entirely and shall no longer have any force or effect.
- 4. Nothing in this Fourth Amendment shall change the Effective Date of the Permit as defined in Section 2.1.

Except as amended herein, all remaining terms and conditions of Permit No. 899 shall remain in full force and effect.
