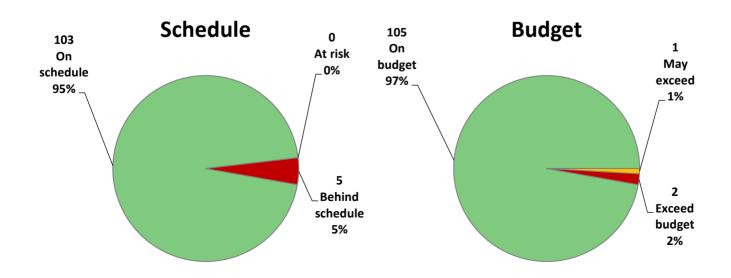

The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 122 Capital projects representing just over \$1 Billion in total project value. 14 projects are currently on hold leaving 108 active projects. From a budget perspective, 105 projects, or roughly 97% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.



The 5 projects that are behind schedule or at risk of falling behind schedule include:

- 1) The B. 218-220 Landside Stowage Pin Relocation project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (12-21).
- 2) State Route SR 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge & Front St/Harbor Blvd Interchange Reconfiguration project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (12-
- 3) San Pedro Waterfront B. 57 Alta Sea Environment Assessment project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust schedule.
- 4) The Wilmington Youth Sailing and Aquatic Center project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (11-20).
- 5) Container Terminals AMP Earth Switchgears Retrofit project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust schedule (9-21)

The 3 projects that are either over budget or at risk of being over budget include:

- 1) The B. 218-220 Landside Stowage Pin Relocation project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget (12-21).
- 2) State Route SR 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge & Front St/Harbor Blvd Interchange Reconfiguration project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the budget (12-21).
- 3) The Wilmington Youth Sailing and Aquatic Center project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the budget (7-20).
