On June 29, 2007, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Los Angeles District (Corps) and the Los Angeles Harbor Department (Port) released a joint Environmental Impact Statement/Environmental Impact Report (EIS/EIR) for the Berth 136-147 [TraPac] Container Terminal Project.

This letter serves to notice of a number of errors in Sections 5.2.1, 5.2.2 and 5.2.3 and one error to Figure ES-4 of the Executive Summary. The enclosed errata has been prepared to provide a summary of changes. Changes are identified as ~~strikeouts~~ for text removed and underline for additions. For Figure ES-4, the original and new versions are included and the change is circled.

Public Meeting: The Corps and the Port will jointly conduct a public meeting to receive public comment on the Draft EIS/EIR and the enclosed Errata on July 31, 2007 at Banning Landing Community Center 100 E. Water Street, Wilmington CA. This meeting is to be conducted in English with simultaneous English/Spanish translation services provided.

Comments: The Draft EIR/EIS was released for a 45-day public review period on June 29, 2007. In addition, five days are being added to the 45-day public review period to accommodate the July 4th Holiday. 
