

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
AND THE CITY OF LONG BEACH**

**ESTABLISHING COSTS TO BE SHARED
UNDER THE CLEAN AIR ACTION PLAN**

CROWLEY MARINE SERVICES, INC.

**ZERO-EMISSIONS CAPABLE PLUG-IN HYBRID TUGBOAT
DEMONSTRATION PROJECT**

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF LOS ANGELES, a municipal corporation, acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners, at its meeting of _____, 2023, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation, acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners, at its meeting of October 9, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Cities of Los Angeles and Long Beach, acting by their respective Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Ports") have entered into Los Angeles Agreement No. 2546/Long Beach Agreement No. HD-7173 ("Master Cost Sharing Agreement") expressing their desire to share the costs of certain contracts related to the San Pedro Bay Ports Clean Air Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Ports are interested in sharing the costs with Crowley Marine Services, Inc., a Delaware corporation. Crowley Marine Services, Inc., in cooperation with ABB, Ltd., and Tetra Tech, Inc., will design, manufacture, and demonstrate in revenue service operation, a battery-dominant, zero-emission capable plug-in hybrid tugboat at the Port of Los Angeles and Port of Long Beach (the "Project") in accordance with the terms of the Master Cost Sharing Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PORTS AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. As part of the Technology Advancement Program, the City of Long Beach has entered into or intends to enter into a funding agreement with Crowley Marine Services, Inc. for the Project.
2. The term of the agreement between the City of Long Beach and Crowley Marine Services, Inc. shall commence upon execution and, subject to the City of Long Beach's right to terminate early, shall terminate on December 31, 2027.
3. The total cost to the Ports for the Project will not exceed \$1,500,000, with each Port paying 50 percent or \$750,000 each.
4. The terms and conditions of the Master Cost Sharing Agreement are incorporated by reference into this agreement and the Ports agree to abide by all the terms and conditions of said agreement.
5. The terms of this cost sharing agreement shall be amended only in writing and signed by both parties.


