GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT AT FRIES AVENUE AND HARRY
BRIDGES BOULEVARD IN WILMINGTON, CA**

In accordance with The Guidelines for Implementation of the Port of Los Angeles Certified Port Master Plan, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners will hold a public hearing to receive public comments relative to the proposed project during a regularly scheduled meeting on December 6, 2012, at 8:30 a.m., located at the Port of Los Angeles Board Room, 425 S. Palos Verdes Street, San Pedro, CA 90731.

Any person unable to attend the public hearing may submit written comments to the Director of Planning & Economic Development, P.O. Box 151, San Pedro, CA 90733. Written comments should be submitted no later than the day before the scheduled public hearing date.
