Proposed Fireboat Maintenance Letter of Agreement (LOA)

■ Background & Need

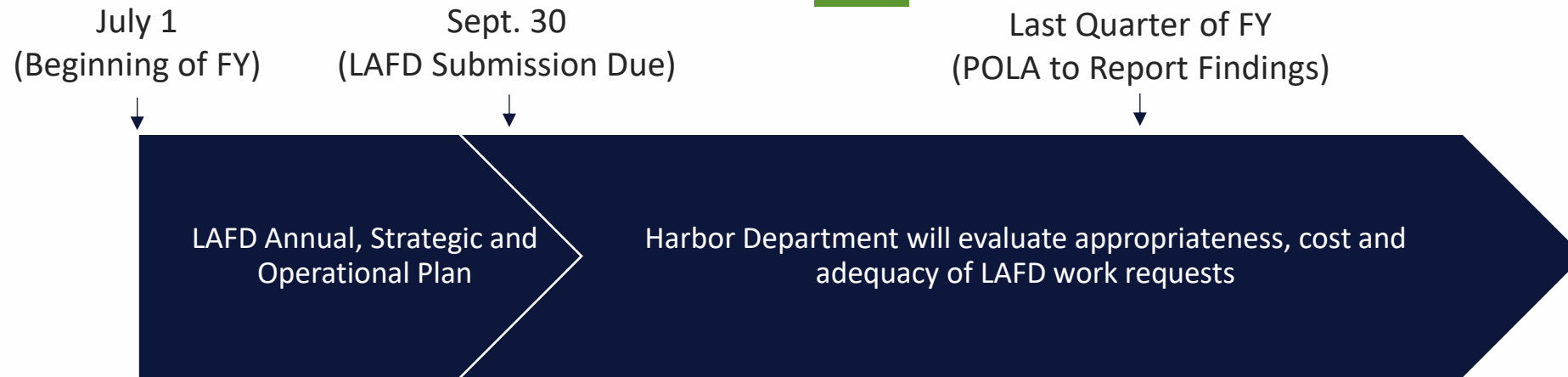
- Five fireboats provide fire services under Memorandum of Understanding 1956 (MOU 1956).
- However, MOU 1956 lacks specificity regarding fireboat maintenance.

■ Purpose

- The proposed Fireboat Maintenance LOA will cover all maintenance, repairs and modifications for the five fireboats.
- It clarifies the process under which emergency, routine and preventative maintenance can be accomplished as well as plan for equipment upgrades.



Maintenance Planning Process under LOA



- **LAFD Responsibilities (due by September 30)**

- Annual Plan: Disclose anticipated work on each fireboat for the following fiscal year.
- Strategic Plan: Provide anticipated work on each fireboat covering the following 10-year period.
- Operational Plan: Submit three-year work plan including projected routine maintenance, component upgrades/replacements, major component overhauls/refits and capital equipment replacement for each fireboat.

- **Harbor Responsibilities (due no later than the last quarter of FY)**

- Review: Evaluate the appropriateness, cost and adequacy of the work proposed by LAFD for its annual approved budget, emergency repairs, any proposed modifications, and/or any cost overruns for previously approved work.
- Reimburse: Make reimbursement determinations based upon the recommendations of a subject matter expert, subject to funds availability.

Key Recommended Actions

- **Approve the Letter of Agreement between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and the City of Los Angeles Fire Department.**
 - This will establish a system to manage fireboat maintenance and the associated costs thereof, including the implementation of a standardized inter-department review, approval and reimbursement process.
 - Covers a three-year term with automatic renewals for additional three-year terms for a maximum term of 15 years or until terminated by either party.
- **Authorize the Executive Director to execute, and the Board Secretary to attest to the proposed Letter of Agreement for and on behalf of the Board.**
