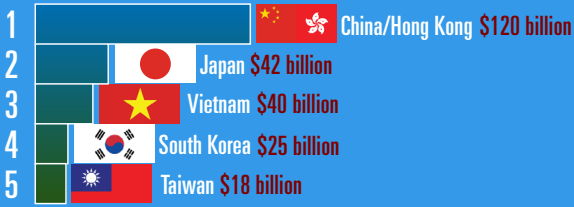

# TOP 5 TRADE ROUTES (CY 2024)

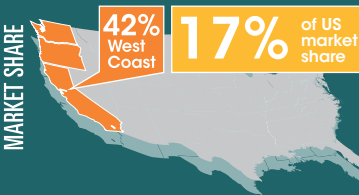

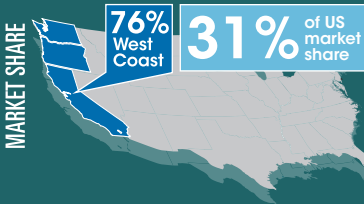
## Port of Los Angeles
