The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 118 active Capital projects representing just under \$1B in total project value. From a budget perspective, 92 of these projects, or roughly 78% of all projects, are currently tracking on budget.

### The 3 projects that are either over budget or at risk of being over budget include:

- 1) The Berths 121-131 (Yang Ming) Terminal Improvements EIR/EIS is over budget and needs PDC action to adjust;
- 2) The Berths 167-169 MOTEMS (Shell) project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust budget;
- 3) The Berth 164 MOTEMS (Valero) project is over budget and needs PDC action to adjust budget;

There are a total of 2 projects behind schedule and 1 project at risk of falling behind schedule.

#### The projects that are behind schedule or are at risk of falling behind schedule include:

- 1) The Berth 164 MOTEMS (Valero) project is delayed and needs PDC Action to change the project schedule:
- 2) The schedule for the Berths 148-151 MOTEMS (Phillips 66) project is under review and may need PDC Action to change the project schedule;
- 3) The Avalon & Fries Street Closure Environmental Assessment is delayed and needs PDC Action to change the project schedule.

There are a total of 23 projects that are currently on hold representing approximately \$523M of CIP budget. The projects/programs on hold include the Berth 121-131 Redevelopment (\$118M), The Berths 306 Development (\$202M), and Berth 57 AltaSea (\$58M)
