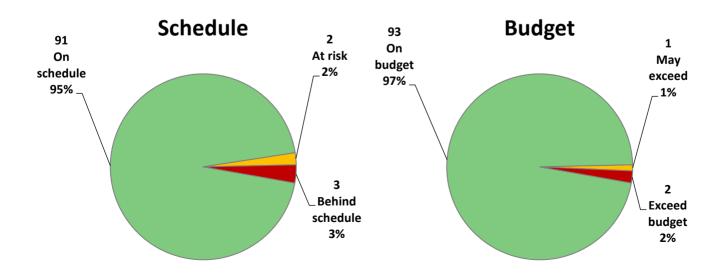

The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 112 Capital projects representing over \$1.1 Billion in total project value. 16 projects are currently on hold leaving 96 active projects. From a budget perspective, 93 projects, or roughly 97% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.



The 5 projects that are behind schedule or at risk of falling behind schedule include:

1) B. 302-305 On-Dock Railyard Expansion project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.

2) Wilmington Waterfront Avalon Pedestrian Bridge project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.(10/22)

3) Wilmington Waterfront Avalon Pedestrian Bridge DWP Marine Tank Farm Coordination project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule. (10/22)

4) B. 46 Outer Harbor Cruise Terminal AMP project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule. (10/22)

5) Harbor Administration Building--HVAC Replacement project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule. (07/22)
