RESOLUTION FOR ALTERNATIVE SITE FRAMEWORK APPLICATION  
TO THE FOREIGN TRADE ZONE BOARD

WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners, on July 14, 1994 received a Grant of Authority to Establish, Operate and Maintain Foreign Trade Zone No. 202 ("FTZ No. 202") in Los Angeles, California; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Harbor Department ("Harbor Department"), as the Foreign Trade Zone ("FTZ") grantee, is required to justify acreage within the zone to the FTZ Board. The FTZ Board mandates that all grantees optimize the amount of acres used within their zone; and

WHEREAS, the FTZ Board now makes available to grantees and Alternative Site Framework (ASF) that facilitates improved and more efficient site approval; and

WHEREAS, ASF designation will enable FTZ No. 202 to better serve industry and more efficiently promote trade; and

WHEREAS, the ASF will enable FTZ No. 202 to more flexibly promote the immediate usage of the FTZ Program; and

WHEREAS, the Harbor Department staff has prepared an Application for Alternative Site Framework (the "Application") specifically to enable it to obtain expedited site approval; and

WHEREAS, the Application defines a specific service area for the ASF for FTZ No. 202; and

WHEREAS, this ASF will provide increased economic benefits to the Port and City of Los Angeles and the greater Southern California region.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners duly authorizes its Executive Director or her designee to submit the Application for Alternative Site Framework for Foreign-Trade Zone 202 to the Foreign-Trade Zones Board.
