

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 09-2153  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES AND  
U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to Agreement No. 09-2153 is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF LOS ANGELES, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board"), and U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION ("CBP") as follows:

1. Section II, "JURISDICTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES" shall be amended to add the following subsection a.:

"a. Clarifications of Specific Responsibilities

Additional or ongoing PSGP undertakings between the parties often involve specific points of agreement that require clarification or further description. The parties therefore also mutually agree as follows:

- i. City shall make available sufficient strands of high-speed data fiber (from the City's interoperable fiber optic network) to facilitate communications from marine terminals to CBP offices via the Golden Spike and Long Beach Maritime Coordination Center;
- ii. City shall be responsible for maintenance of the interoperable fiber optic network under its jurisdiction and control;
- iii. CBP shall be responsible for maintenance of security-related equipment (radiation portal monitors, etc.) and supporting information technology network equipment under its jurisdiction and control;
- iv. Where possible and consistent with internal security protocols, the parties agree to share video feeds of area surveillance cameras."

2. Except as amended herein, all remaining terms and conditions of Agreement No. 09-2153 shall remain in full force and effect.


