SUBJECT: CIRCULATION OF PROPOSED ADDENDUM PREPARED BY SA RECYCLING FOR THE PROPOSED SA RECYCLING LEASE EXTENSION

SA Recycling has prepared an Addendum to the Port of Los Angeles 1996 certified Hugo Neu-Proler Lease Renewal EIR (Certified EIR), State Clearinghouse No. 93071074, for a proposed five-year extension to their current lease. There are no proposed changes to SA Recycling's current operation. SA Recycling has shared this Draft Addendum with the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) in the hopes that Harbor Department staff will present this item to the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) for consideration.
