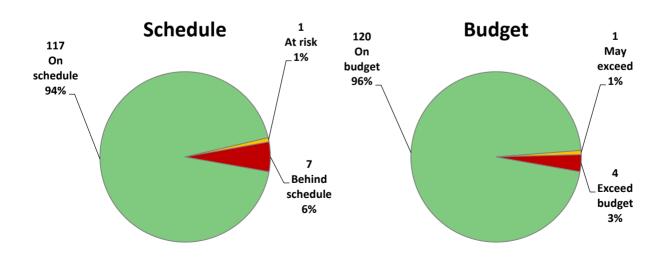

From a budget perspective, 120 projects, or roughly 96% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.
