RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING ANTONIO V. GIOIELLO AS AN ALTERNATE TO THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE ALAMEDA CORRIDOR TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, in December 1996, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners and the City Council of the City of Los Angeles approved the "Amended and Restated Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement between the City of Long Beach and the City of Los Angeles to be known as the Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority"; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.B of the "Amended and Restated Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement between the City of Long Beach and the City of Los Angeles to be known as the Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority" provides that the alternate member for the Executive Director of the Governing Board shall be a member of the Los Angeles Harbor Department staff; and

WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners is the appointing authority for the Port of Los Angeles on the Governing Board of the Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority; and

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2015, Antonio V. Gioiello was appointed by the Board of Harbor Commissioners to the ACTA Governing Board as the alternate to the Executive Director for a five-year term; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to reappoint Mr. Gioiello for an additional five-year term, beginning on March 20, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners does hereby reappoint Antonio V. Gioiello as the alternate to the Executive Director on the Governing Board of the Alameda Corridor Transportation Authority for a term of five (5) years, expiring on March 20, 2025.
