ORDER NO. _____

WHEREAS, Item No. 1670 of the Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4 provides that any hulk, derelict, wreck or part of any ship, vessel or other watercraft sunk, beached, or allowed to remain in an unseaworthy or dilapidated condition upon tide and submerged lands in the Harbor District for a period longer than 30 days without a watchman or other person being maintained upon or near and in charge of such property and without the consent by resolution of the Board of Harbor Commissioners, is subject to be declared abandoned by Order of the Board of Harbor Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, upon the declaration of abandonment, any such hulk, derelict, wreck, or part of any ship, vessel or other watercraft may be sold, destroyed or otherwise disposed of not less than ten (10) days after the final adoption and publication of an Order by the City; and

WHEREAS, an unidentified vessel described as a 75-foot fiberglass fishing boat has not been operated or maintained since left abandoned at Berth 162, the former Wilmington Marine Services, Inc. facility, in the Port of Los Angeles and is in a dilapidated and unseaworthy condition; and

WHEREAS, the unidentified vessel has been inspected and no numbers, documents, or marks have been found on it that identify any registration with the California Department of Motor Vehicles or the United States Coast Guard's National Vessel Documentation Center and, despite efforts to discover them, no person has come forward to take responsibility for the vessel;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Harbor Commissioners finds that the unidentified vessel is dilapidated and unseaworthy vessel abandoned at Berth 162 for more than 30 days without a watchman or other person being maintained at, upon or near and in charge of the vessel, and without the consent of the Board expressed by resolution, and hereby orders that the vessel be disposed of in accordance with Item No. 1670 of Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4.
