## LEVEL I COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT REPORT

**DATE: APRIL 18, 2016**

**TO: HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF HARBOR  
COMMISSIONERS**

### BACKGROUND

In accordance with the approved Port of Los Angeles Master Plan (PMP), the Executive Director is designated with the authority to approve or deny applications for Level I Coastal Development Permits (CDP), but these CDPs only become effective when the permits are reported in writing to the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board). No Board action is required. Additionally, the PMP provides that a Level I CDP that is being reported to the Board can be stayed if any two Board members so request. In this case, the CDP would be agendaized for the next regular Board meeting and would require Board action to be approved or denied.

### PERMIT ACTIONS

The Executive Director has approved one Level I CDP:

CDP No. 16-10 POLA – Installation of Fitness Equipment at Wilmington Waterfront Park, Harbor Blvd Parkway, and 22nd Street Park

The project location for the approved CDP is identified on the attached map (Transmittal 1).

**CDP No. 16-10 POLA – Installation of Fitness Equipment at Wilmington Waterfront Park, Harbor Blvd Parkway, and 22nd Street Park**

CDP No. 16-10 (Transmittal 2) allows the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) to install fitness equipment at Wilmington Waterfront Park, Harbor Blvd Parkway, and 22nd Street Park as outlined in the Application for Port Permit (APP) No. 160418-054. Fitness equipment on the Los Angeles Waterfront would provide community benefits that promote a healthy lifestyle, increase visitor-serving activities, and enhance existing Los Angeles Waterfront assets.

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SUBJECT: LEVEL I CDP REPORT

The estimated project cost is \$183,000 and will be paid by Harbor Department. Funds for the fitness equipment and installation have been budgeted in Account 59994, Center No. 1169, Program No. 000. It is expected that all funds will be spent this fiscal year. Equipment maintenance will be performed by the Construction and Maintenance Division.
