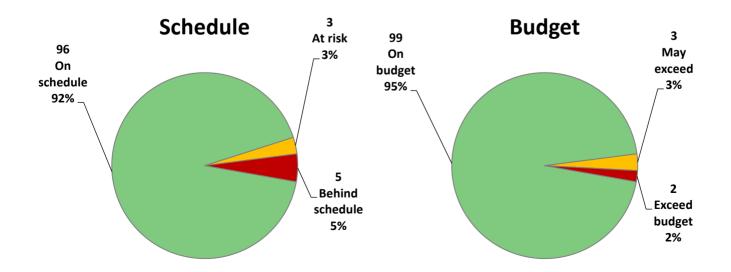

The Engineering Division is currently tracking a total of 119 Capital projects representing over \$1.1 Billion in total project value. 15 projects are currently on hold leaving 104 active projects. From a budget perspective, 99 projects, or roughly 95% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.



The 8 projects that are behind schedule or at risk of falling behind schedule include:

1) B. 177-178 Wharf Restoration project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule.

2) B. 179-181 Wharf and Bollard Repair project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule

3) The B. 218-220 Landside Stowage Pin Relocation project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (12-21).

4) B. 238-239 MOTEMS PBF Energy project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.

5) State Route SR 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge & Front St/Harbor Blvd Interchange Reconfiguration project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule (12-21).

6) Harbor Administration Building--HVAC Replacement project is under review and needs PDC action to adjust the schedule.

7) B. 161--Former Administration Builidng Remodel project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.

8) B. 182 Slope Erosion Repair project is under review and may need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
