Cyber Resilience Center





- <u>Establishment:</u> Operational since December 2021. State-of-the-art facility completed in October 2022
- <u>Management:</u> Operated and managed by IBM with Port oversight. Staffed fulltime by cybersecurity analysts with industry certifications
- <u>Processes:</u> ISO 27001 certification for Information Security Management System (*Pending October 2023*)
- <u>Collaboration</u>: Port ecosystem stakeholders (e.g., Port CSOC, City of LA, terminal operators, shipping lines, railroad companies and other partners)

Cyber Resilience Center





- Reduce cyber risks that could disrupt the flow of cargo
- Early warning system for the ecosystem with improved quality, quantity and speed of cyber information sharing
- Greater collective knowledge of relevant cyber threats in the supply chain community
- Collaboration forum for stakeholder cyber personnel
- Information/advisory resource for recovery
- Non-invasive, non-disruptive to existing cyber security operations

Proposed CRC Budget



- Current Approved Budget: \$6,800,000
- Proposed Additional Budget: \$5,000,000
 - CRC Solution Enhancements and Implementation : \$1,504,006
 - Software and Hardware Maintenance : \$854,858
 - Operations and Maintenance Support including On-site Staffing: \$2,301,770
 - Additional Contingency : \$339,366
- Total Proposed NTE Budget : \$11,800,000

Staff Recommendation



Staff Recommends that the Board:

- Approve the First Amendment to Agreement No. 20-3776 between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department and International Business Machines Corporation for hardware, software and services required to enhance, operate, maintain, and support the turn-key Cyber Resilience Center solution:
 - increase the not-to-exceed compensation amount by \$5,000,000 (total NTE compensation of \$11,800,000)
 - extend the term for additional two years (total of five years) to December 8, 2025
