SUBJECT: **RECENT AMENDMENT TO PORT OF LOS ANGELES TARIFF NO. 4**

The City of Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners approved Temporary Order No. 22-7326 on April 28, 2022, applying a General Rate Increase (GRI) of 7.1% to Tariff No. 4 rated tariff items. The rate increase will be effective August 1, 2022 for the following items:

- Section 4 “Dockage”, Items 450 & 480
- Section 5 “Wharfage”, Items 550-001 - 550-801
- Section 7 “Free Time, Wharf Demurrage, and Wharf Storage” Items 780 & 790
- Section 9 “Container Cranes”, Item 900
- Section 11 “Charges for Occupancy of Office Space, etc. in Transit Sheds and on Wharves and Wharf Premises”, Item 1100
- Section 12 “Water and Electricity”, Item 1200
- Section 14 “Cargo Handling” Item 1415
- Section 15 “Public Landings”, Items 1525 & 1530
- Section 18 “General Rules and Regulations-Miscellaneous”, Item 1802
- Section 19 “Commercial Fishing Vessel”, Items 1910 & 1930
