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A temporary Order of the Board of Harbor Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles amending Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4.

THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES DOES HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Port of Los Angeles Tariff No. 4, adopted July 12, 1989, by Order No. 5837, and Ordinance No. 165,789, adopted April 10, 1990, as amended, is further amended as set forth in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article III, Class 1(31) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.

Section 3. The Board Secretary shall certify to the adoption of this Order by the Board of Harbor Commissioners and shall cause the same to be published once in a daily newspaper printed and published in the City of Los Angeles as well as posted electronically on the Port of Los Angeles website, to take effect prior to adoption by Ordinance for a period not to exceed 90 days pursuant to Charter Section 653(b), commencing effective October 1, 2023.

Upon expiration of free time, storage charges will be assessed under the provisions of Item No. 790. (b) Merchandise on Demurrage or Storage: Merchandise on demurrage or storage will be subject to storage under the storage rates in this section during the period in which the strike is in effect. The Executive Director reserves the right to authorize storage rates for strikebound cargo without prior request. (c) Charge applicable after the strike ends: Merchandise which was previously strikebound remaining on hand on the sixteenth day following the end of the strike will be subject to demurrage, unless prior authorization has been granted by the Executive Director for storage or space assignment.	750
