Subject: <u>RESCHEDULED PUBLIC HEARING ON</u> COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT ISSUANCE

(SAN PEDRO, Calif.) – The Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners will hold a public hearing regarding the issuance of a coastal development permit during its regular meeting on Wednesday, December 4, at 8:30 a.m. Meetings are held in the Port Administration Building's Board Hearing Room, located at 425 South Palos Verdes Street, in San Pedro.

The coastal development under consideration involves the proposed demolition of the Union Ice Co. building, located at 301 South Neptune Avenue, near Berth 142 in Wilmington, Calif.
