SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. _____ - APPROVE ORDER RESETTING

COMPENSATION UNDER PERMIT NO. 999 WITH CHINA SHIPPING

NORTH AMERICA HOLDING CO., LTD.

SUMMARY:

Staff requests approval of the Order resetting compensation under Permit No. 999 (P999) between the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) and China Shipping North America Holding Co., Ltd. (China Shipping) for the operation of a container terminal in the West Basin. The reset covers the five-year period of June 28, 2015 through June 27, 2020 and will result in an aggregate increase of \$619,115.52 in minimum annual guarantee (MAG) over the period, which is the financial responsibility of China Shipping.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board):

- Find that the proposed action is administratively exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Article II Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines as determined by the Director of Environmental Management;
- 2. Approve the Order resetting compensation under Permit No. 999 with China Shipping North America Holding Co., Ltd. for the five-year period of June 28, 2015 to June 27, 2020;
- 3. Authorize the Board Secretary to attest to the Order resetting compensation to be paid by China Shipping North America Holding Co., Ltd. pursuant to Section 3 (g) of Permit No. 999 and;

4. Adopt Resolution No and Order No

DISCUSSION:

<u>Background</u> – P999 has a term of 25 years that commenced on June 28, 2005, and expires on June 27, 2030. P999 grants China Shipping non-exclusive use of 130.56 acres at Berths 100-102, which is subject to a (MAG) and Twenty Foot Equivalent Units (TEU) charges.

As required under the City Charter, P999 requires that compensation be reset every five years. The current compensation structure under P999 has several major components:

- 1) Payment of TEU charges. TEU charges are set based on a sliding scale that provides discounts as higher volumes are achieved. The TEU charges are subject to increases based on any increase in the Not Otherwise Specified (N.O.S.) cargo rate in Tariff No. 4.
- 2) Payment of MAG. If TEU charges fail to reach the revenue per acre as established by the MAG, the value established by the MAG becomes the baseline for minimum rent due the Harbor Department. MAG is also subject to increase based on any increase in the N.O.S. cargo rate in Tariff No. 4.
- 3) Combined Compensation with Yang Ming Transport Corporation.
- 4) Empty and Transshipped Container Discounts.

<u>Proposed Compensation</u> - Staff proposes that compensation under P999 for the period of June 28, 2015 through June 27, 2020 be as follows:

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ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The proposed action is approval of an Order resetting compensation under Permit No. 999 with China Shipping. As an administrative activity, the Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is exempt from the requirements of CEQA in accordance with Article II Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The Order resetting compensation (Transmittal 1) for the period of June 28, 2015 through June 27, 2020 will increase the amount of rent for the permit premises (Transmittal 2). As a result, MAG revenue to the Harbor Department will increase by a total of \$619,115.52 for the five-year period.

As stipulated in Section 3(g) of the P999, the Order resetting compensation is retroactive to June 28, 2015. Should China Shipping exceed the MAG in any given year, the Harbor Department will receive compensation in excess of the MAG
