

SR 47 INTERCHANGE PROJECT

LANE CLOSURES ON FRONT STREET
BETWEEN PACIFIC AVENUE AND NORTHBOUND SR 47 ON-RAMP

WHAT:

Crews will reduce Front Street between Pacific Avenue and the northbound SR 47 on-ramp to one lane in each direction for approximately nine months. This lane reduction is necessary to allow crews to safely perform construction activities at this location for the SR 47 Improvement Project.

In order to facilitate the lane reduction, crews will intermittently close lanes during daytime and nighttime hours along Front Street between Pacific Avenue and the northbound SR 47 on-ramp to restripe lanes, place k-rail and reconfigure the signalized intersection at Front Street and Knoll Drive. Access to China Shipping will be maintained at all times during these activities.

FRONT ST. INTERMITTENT LANE CLOSURES:

FRONT ST. LANE REDUCTION:

Friday, July 12, 2024 for approximately nine months

FRONT STREET ALTERNATE ROUTES:

- A) FROM FRONT STREET:
 - 1. Continue south on Front Street
 - 2. Turn right on 1st Street
 - 3. Turn right on Pacific Avenue

- B) FROM PACIFIC AVENUE:
 - 1. Continue south on Pacific Avenue
 - 2. Turn left on 1st Street
 - 3. Turn left on Harbor Boulevard to access Front Street

The SR 47 Interchange Project will replace the existing southbound SR 47 off-ramp from the Vincent Thomas Bridge, currently on the south side, with a new off-ramp on the north side. Additional improvements include realigning the existing on-ramp to the northbound I-110 connector; modifying the northbound SR 47 off-ramp onto Harbor Boulevard; modifying the northbound SR 47 on-ramp onto the bridge toward Terminal Island; and improving local streets near the interchange.
