LEVEL I COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT REPORT

DATE: AUGUST 31, 2016

TO: HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF HARBOR COMMISSIONERS

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the approved Port of Los Angeles Master Plan (PMP), the Executive Director is designated with the authority to approve or deny applications for Level I Coastal Development Permits (CDP), but these CDPs only become effective when the permits are reported in writing to the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board). No Board action is required. Additionally, the PMP provides that a Level I CDP that is being reported to the Board can be stayed if any two Board members so request. In this case, the CDP would be agendized for the next regular Board meeting and would require Board action to be approved or denied.

PERMIT ACTIONS

The Executive Director has approved one Level I CDP:

CDP No. 16-16 City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power – Removing approximately 66 feet of 12-inch and 6-inch fuel pipelines under the deck and removing the free-standing structures adjacent to the pipeline header system at Berths 180 and 181.

The project location for the approved CDP is identified on the attached map (Transmittal 1).

CDP No. 16-16 City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power – Removing approximately 66 feet of 12-inch and 6-inch fuel pipeline under the deck and removing the free-standing structure adjacent to the pipeline header system at Berths 180 and 181.

CDP No. 16-16 (Transmittal 2) allows the City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) to remove approximately 66 feet of 12-inch and 6-inch fuel pipeline suspended under the deck at Berths 180 and 181 as outlined in the Application for Port

SUBJECT: LEVEL I CDP REPORT

Permit (APP) No. 160616-083. Additionally, three ten-foot by ten-foot free-standing Operator Shacks adjacent to the pipeline header system will be removed.

The estimated project cost is \$160,000 and will be paid by the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.
