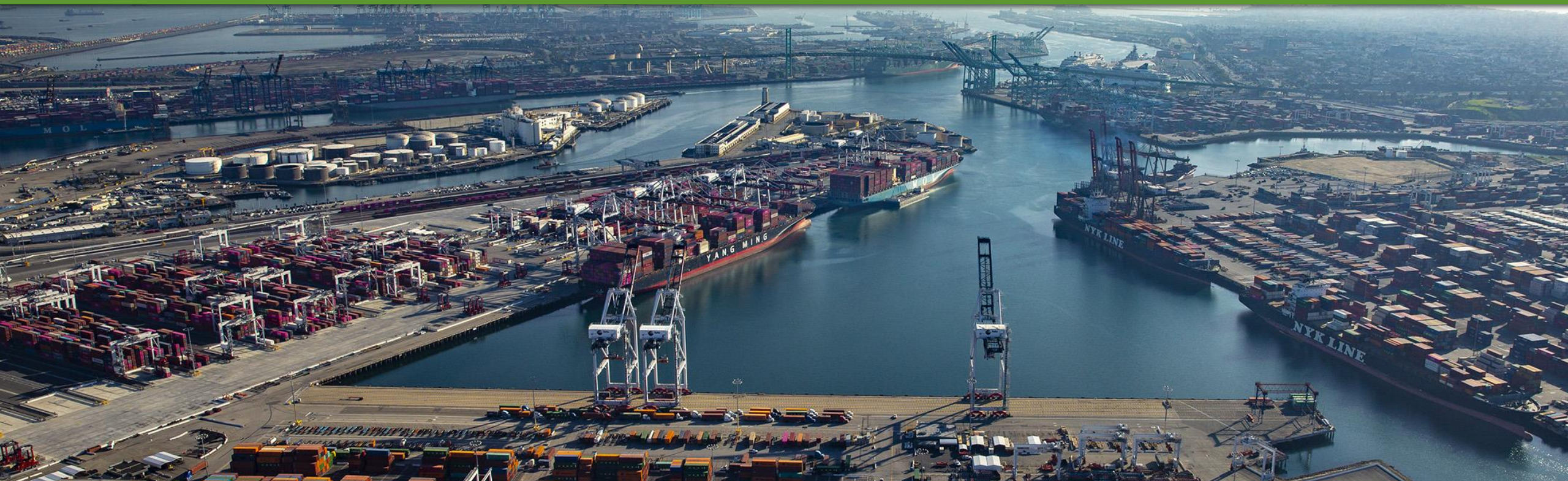

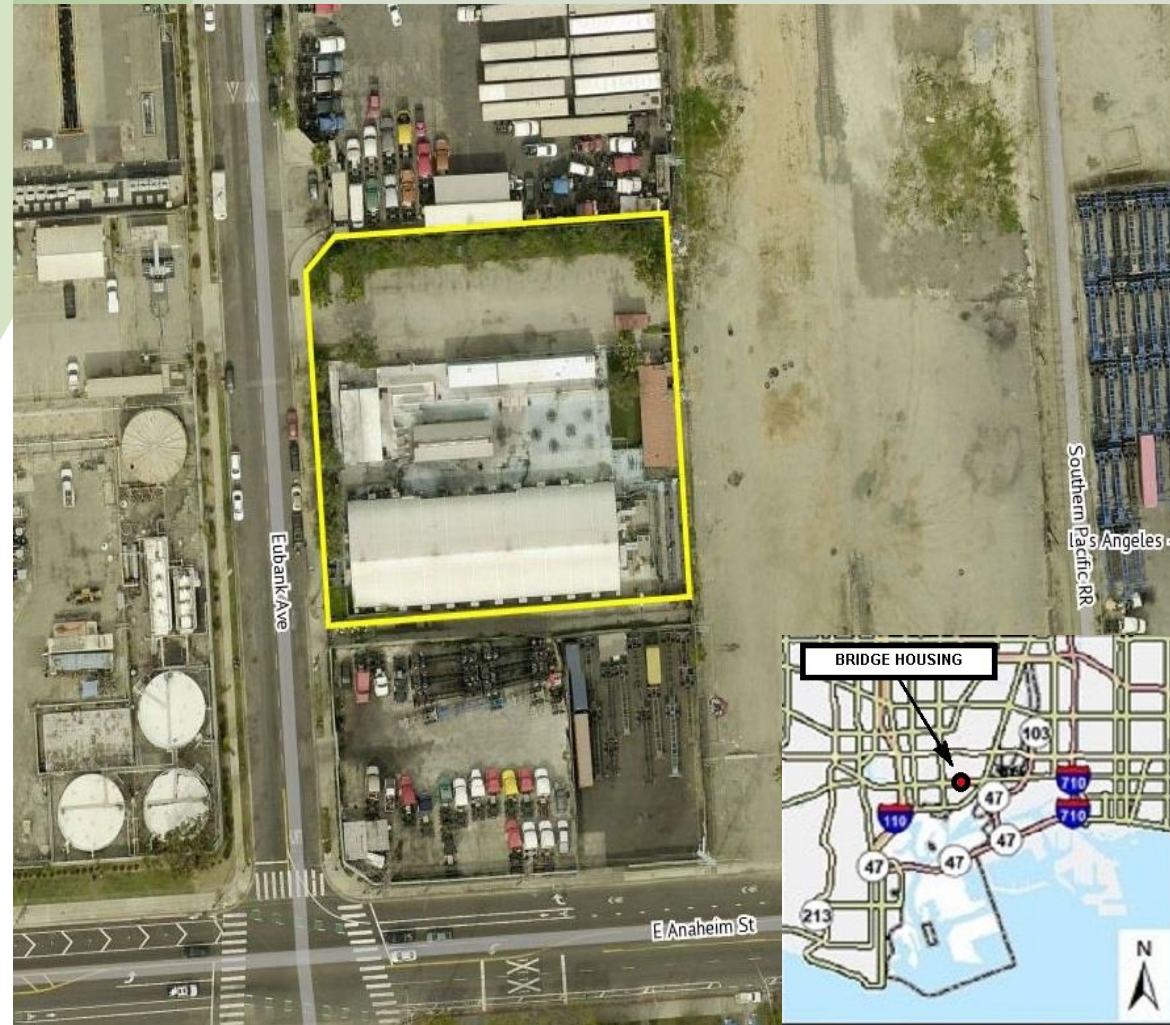

Proposed Revocable Permit with GSD

Today's action supports Mayor Bass' initiatives to address the homelessness crisis

- Staff requests approval of successor Revocable Permit No. 23-11 with GSD
- GSD continue to operate facility for unhoused individuals for a term up to 42 months
- Compensation to the Harbor Department will continue to be \$125 per year
- If property is needed long-term, Port staff and GSD will pursue parallel property transaction



Recommendation

Staff requests approval of successor Revocable Permit No. 23-11 with GSD

- This temporary accommodation facility will address critical issues facing the region and aim to serve and accommodate the needs of the unhoused in and around the Port of Los Angeles
- Find that entering into the Revocable Permit is in the best interest of the City of Los Angeles despite certain exceptions to the Leasing Policy
- Find that there is no immediate need for a public-trust-compliant use at this location and it will not interfere with public trust needs
- Find that the use as a bridge housing facility in temporary, interim use
