WHEREAS, on September 28, 2005, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board") adopted Resolution 6385, which requires advance approval by the Board where feasible for all Commissioner travel for which reimbursement is requested; and

WHEREAS, President Lucille Roybal-Allard will travel to Washington, D.C. from June 10, 2024 through June 14, 2024; and

WHEREAS, President Roybal-Allard will be accompanied by Port of Los Angeles (POLA) Executive Director, Eugene D. Seroka, POLA Deputy Executive Director of Stakeholder Engagement, David Libatique and POLA Senior Director of Workforce & Government Affairs, Avin Sharma; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this travel is to meet with Congressional members and Biden-Harris Administration officials to provide a POLA operations update and brief members on POLA grant priorities; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of this trip for President Roybal-Allard, which includes refundable airfare, lodging and per diem is not to exceed \$3,000; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the travel of Commission President Roybal-Allard to Washington, D.C. from June 10, 2024 through June 14, 2024 be approved.
