SAN PEDRO, Calif. – As part of a four-city tour, Westport Innovations Inc.'s High Pressure Direct Injection (HPDI) Heavy Duty LNG Truck Tour will stop at the Port of Los Angeles this Thursday, May 11 from 3 to 5 p.m. Westport's LNG big rig will be displayed at the Port's Berth 87, located at Harbor Blvd. and 1st Street, and company representatives will be on hand to answer questions.
