SAN PEDRO, Calif. – Months after conducting initial discussions garnering tremendous response from the Harbor community on specific traffic issues, the Port of Los Angeles will hold community workshops in both San Pedro and Wilmington to present construction solutions for Port-area traffic, centering on connections to the I-110 (Harbor Freeway) and SR-47 (Vincent Thomas Bridge).

Both workshops will cover the same information, held in conjunction with two Port of Los Angeles Community Advisory Committee (PCAC) subcommittee meetings.
