

APPROVAL FOR COMMISSION VICE PRESIDENT EDWARD R. RENWICK TO TRAVEL ON A BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT TRIP TO SINGAPORE

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2005, the Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners ("Board") adopted Resolution 6385, which requires advance approval by the Board where feasible for all Commissioner travel for which reimbursement is requested, and

WHEREAS, a Port of Los Angeles business development trip to Singapore is planned for April 21, 2023 through April 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Board Vice President Edward R. Renwick will be accompanied by Port of Los Angeles Executive Director Eugene D. Seroka to attend Singapore Maritime Week and meet with the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this travel is to formally sign a Memorandum of Understanding among the Port of Los Angeles, Port of Long Beach and the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore to establish a Green Shipping Corridor ("MOU"); and

WHEREAS, the MOU will promote collaboration among the participating ports to further the mutual goals for decarbonization by advancing environmental performance in the maritime shipping industry and improving supply chain efficiencies through information digitalization; and


WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of Vice President Edward R. Renwick's portion of this trip is not to exceed \$20,000; and
