- 5) What are some green/sustainable applications or remedial approaches that you have used on current or historical projects (does not have to be port-related)? (15 points)
- 6) Share ONE challenging project that your team has worked on within the last 5 years. Identify the challenge(s) and how did your team overcome them? (15 points)
- 7) Does your company (not necessarily your office only) work for any of the Port's tenants? How would you determine if there is a conflict of interest? What would you do if there is a conflict? (10 points)
- 8) How do you ensure prompt monthly invoicing of charges? (8 points)
