- 2. Upon approval of this SECOND AMENDMENT by the Board of Harbor Commissioners and City Council, Operator shall receive a one-time reimbursement of \$28,758.62 for providing services in connection with the Harbor Department hosted inaugural 2016 Los Angeles Navy Fleet Week.
- 3. Page 1 of Exhibit E entitled COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT is amended to include:
 - Payment for Additional Events Hosted by the City.

Operator shall provide and be compensated for additional event services as may, from time to time, be required by City, but, in no event, shall such services or compensation exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) during the remaining term of this Agreement."

Except as amended herein, all remaining terms and conditions of Agreement No. 13-3112 shall remain in full force and effect.
