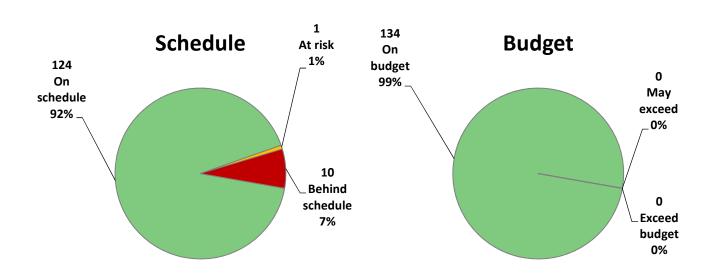

- 9) 1025 S Seaside Ave Demolition and Lot Conversion is behind schedule and will need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
- 10) Port-wide Leak Detection Expansion Program is behind schedule and will need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
- 11) Port of Los Angeles Energy Monitoring System is behind schedule and will need PDC action to adjust the schedule.
