

RESOLUTION NO 6416

WHEREAS, the I-710 freeway is a vital transportation artery linking the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach to the greater Los Angeles area and beyond and is an essential component of the regional, statewide and national transportation system, serving both passenger needs and goods movement;

WHEREAS, due to, increasing traffic volumes including cargo movements and existing design deficiencies, the I-710 freeway requires upgrade to enhance safety and air quality;

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Gateway Cities Council of Governments, along with the MTA, Caltrans, and the Southern California Association of Governments initiated the I-710 Freeway Major Corridor Study ("Study") to analyze traffic congestion and mobility problems, with a goal of developing transportation solutions to improve the movement of users of the I-710 Freeway that preserve and enhance the quality of life of the surrounding neighborhoods and communities;

WHEREAS, an Oversight Policy Committee, comprised of twenty public agencies including the corridor cities and the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, was also formed in 2001 to guide the Study and provide recommendations on the findings of the study;

WHEREAS, an Executive Committee has been established to move forward the decisions of the I-710 EIR/EIS Project Committee (formerly the Oversight Policy Committee); and

WHEREAS, it is now appropriate for the City of Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners to designate the regular member and an alternate member on the Executive Committee of the I-710 Corridor Improvement Program;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners appoints Commissioner Jerilyn López-Mendoza as the regular member and Commissioner Douglas Krause as the alternate member to represent the Los Angeles Harbor Department on the Executive Committee of the I-710 Corridor Improvement Program for a term not greater than four years unless modified by action of the Board of Harbor Commissioners. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
