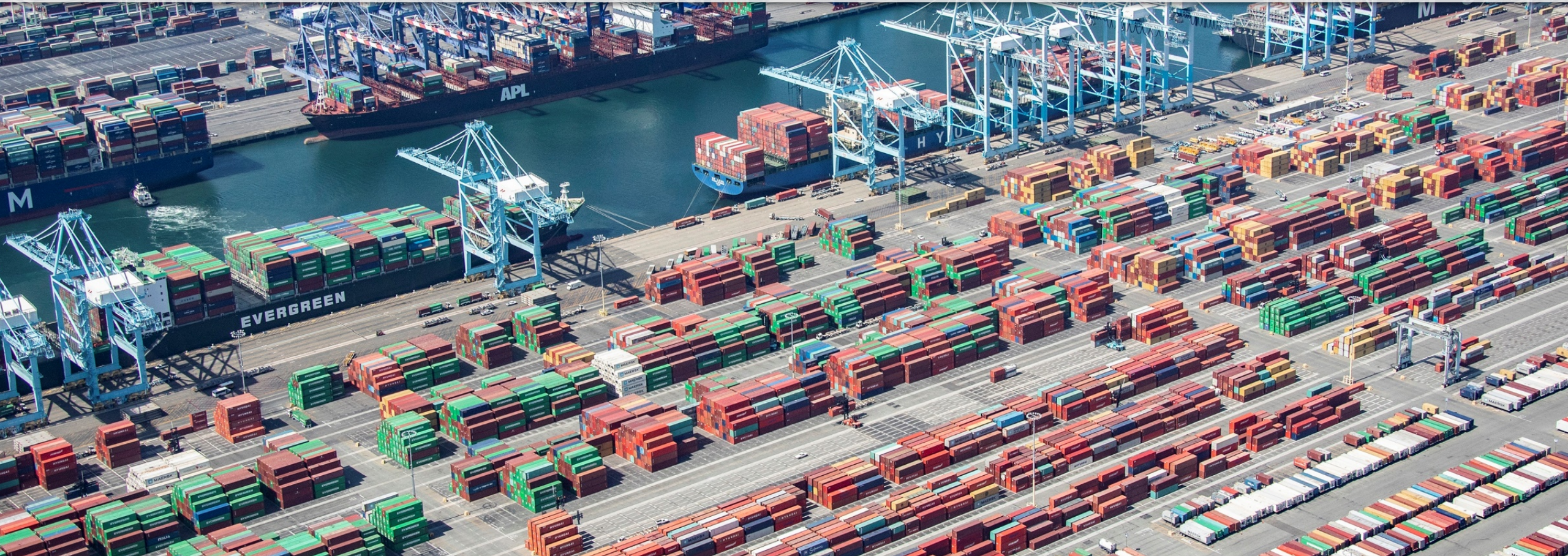

# PURPOSE

- Present framework for an MOU between the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach
- Seek your comments on the framework
- September 5 - Board consideration of the MOU



# BACKGROUND



- San Pedro Bay Complex – 37% of all waterborne goods enter the US through this gateway representing \$312 billion in trade value
- Close proximity to Asia providing direct access to all 435 US Congressional districts
- Extensive Rail network
- Access to nearly 2 billion square feet of warehouses
- Over 3400 acres spread over 13 container terminals
- 15,000 longshore personnel
- 1,100 motor carriers and 16,000 truck drivers
- Handling 60,000 truck moves daily
- Three major shipping line alliances

# POLA-POLB STRATEGICALLY ALIGNED

## POLA Strategic Plan

- ***A Secure, Efficient and Environmentally Sustainable Supply Chain*** - Facilitate supply chain efficiencies and terminal velocity with supply chain partners

## POLB Strategic Plan

- ***Strengthen the Port's competitive position through secure and efficient movement of cargo while providing outstanding customer service***



# VALUE PROPOSED

- **FMC Agreement 201219 allows for joint collaboration that benefits the San Pedro Bay area and nation**
- **SP Bay must remain competitive**
- **Must ensure velocity, predictability and reliability**
- **Ports of LA and LB seek to discuss opportunities for service enhancements at landside transfer points, technology, training and security**

- September 5, 2019 – POLA Board of Harbor Commissioners to consider approval of the MOU between the City of Los Angeles and City of Long Beach
- If approved, bi-annual updates on progress made to the respective Boards
