**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. _____ FOR THE APPROVAL OF
CHANGES TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PORT OF LOS ANGELES
COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

SUMMARY:

As required by the Port of Los Angeles Community Advisory Committee (PCAC) By-laws, the Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) is being asked to approve changes in the PCAC membership for the Wilmington Neighborhood Council.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Harbor Commissioners:

1. Approve Robert Jasso as the Wilmington Neighborhood Council Voting Member;
2. Approve Dan Domonoske as the Wilmington Neighborhood Council Alternate Member; and
3. Adopt Resolution No. _____.

DISCUSSION:

Background/Context – The PCAC was established as a standing committee of the Board. PCAC's organization, structure, and membership were approved in a series of actions by the Board in 2001.

The PCAC membership consists of a variety of stakeholder groups in the San Pedro, Wilmington, and Harbor City communities which represent neighborhood councils, resident groups, business and industry groups, organized labor, and education. As stated in the PCAC By-laws, all voting members and alternates shall be nominated by their respective organizations or appointing authorities and approved by the Board.

The Wilmington Neighborhood Council has advised the City of Los Angeles Harbor Department (Harbor Department) of their desire to appoint Robert Jasso as their new voting representative and Dan Domonoske as their new alternate representative, as

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stated in the attached letter dated February 6, 2013 (Transmittal 1). Mr. Jasso will fill the voting seat that was vacated by Jack Babbitt in July 2012. Mr. Domonoske will fill the alternate seat that was vacated by Marcus Perez in May 2012.

These actions are consistent with the Board's directions to participating organizations regarding changes in representation as determined by a vote of the organization.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The proposed action is approval of a change to the PCAC membership. As an administrative activity, the Director of Environmental Management has determined that the proposed action is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) in accordance with Article II, Section 2(f) of the Los Angeles City CEQA Guidelines.

ECONOMIC BENEFITS:

This Board action has no employment effect.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

PCAC does not have any designated Harbor Department facility space such as office space, parking space, etc. Approval of the proposed PCAC membership change is not expected to have a financial impact upon the Harbor Department.

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
CITY ATTORNEY:
