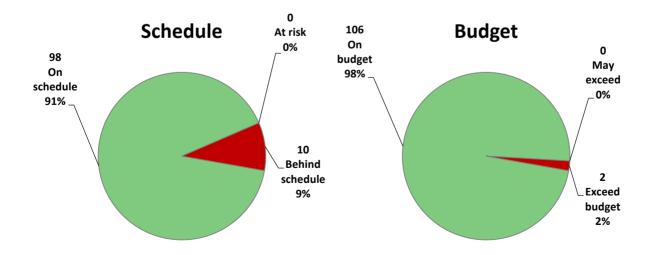

From a budget perspective, 105 projects, or roughly 97% of all active projects, are currently tracking on budget.
