- Partnership established in 2013
- Initially funded by state and federal grants and reimbursements from DBW
- Continued funding provided by combination of student tuition, grant funds, and in-kind support from partnering agencies
- Specifically designed to train state and local law enforcement, including PORT Police Officers
- To provide instruction, RMLETC partners with local police agencies (LAPD, LBPD, LASD, OCSD, SBSB, SDHPD, US Coast Guard, LA City Attorney's Office, LA Corner/Medical Offices etc.)
- Nation's first port-based maritime law enforcement training center on West Coast
- Instruction includes classroom settings as well as hands on learning in a safe and controlled environment with trained professional staff to assist
- The only POST-certified and federal recognized RMLETC on West Coast
- Certified instructors used from partnering agencies and PORT Police Officers
