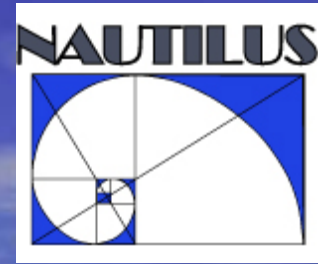

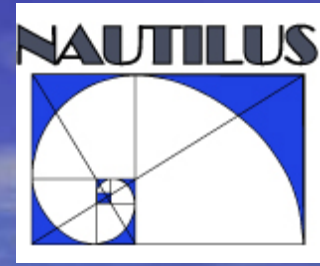
Cal Maritime is #1 for Upper-Income Mobility

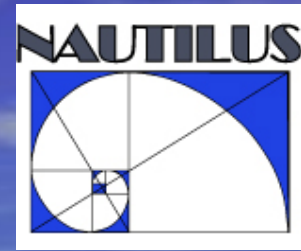

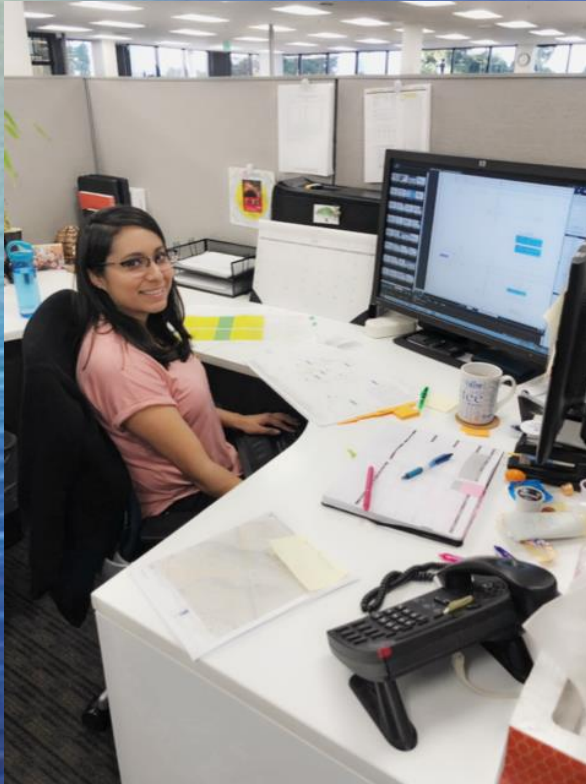


Banning HS / EXP graduates attending Cal Maritime

- 5 have received Masters degrees

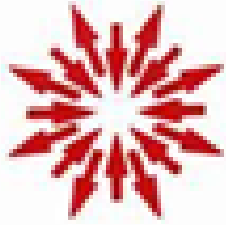

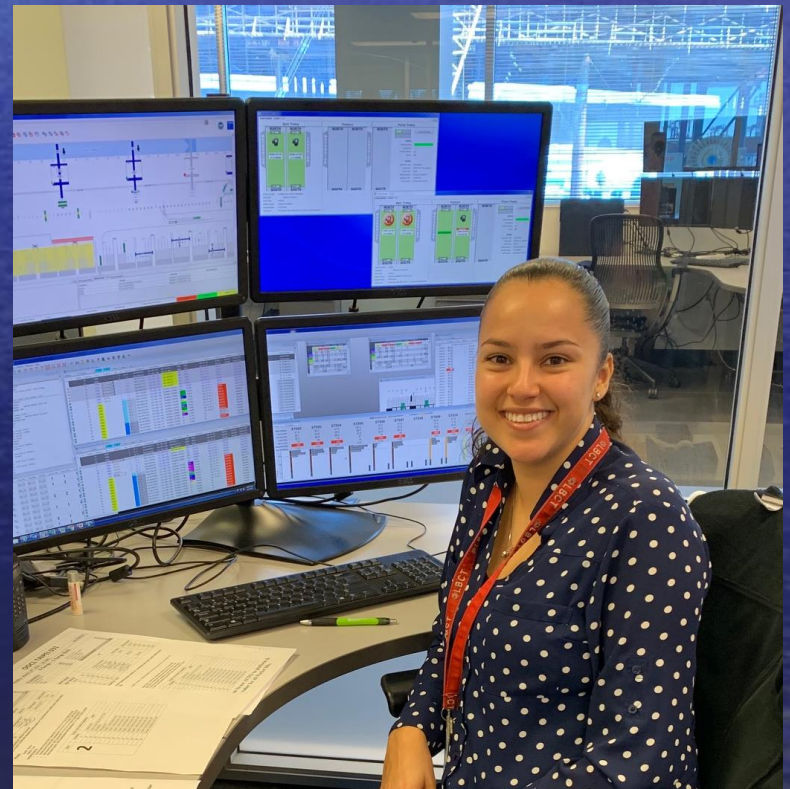

Banning HS / EXP / Cal Maritime Scholarship

- Open to Banning HS / EXP graduates.
Must FAFSA eligible
- Over \$850,000 (fy 23/24) has been raised for
51 students since 2007

- **Need a maritime industry partner (POLA / Metro Ports)**

- **Get the HS students on campus early and often. (Cal Maritime / EXP summer trip)**
