SUBJECT: MAY 2021 PROJECT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

This report highlights the actions taken by the Project Development Committee (PDC) at its May meeting. On May 5, 2021, the PDC met to consider eight project items. The committee also reviewed standing reports regarding newly opened work orders, the status of the unallocated Capital Improvement Program (CIP) fund budget, the financial model, and the GASB 49 project list. Attached for review are the meeting minutes (Transmittal 1) and Unallocated CIP Fund Report FY 2020/2021 (Transmittal 2).

The following is a summary of the meeting minutes by category:

- 1) Schedule change Five items were submitted and approved.
- 2) Budget/Schedule/Scope change One item was submitted and approved.
- 3) New project Two items were submitted and approved.

The Board of Harbor Commissioners (Board) approved \$12,000,000 in the fiscal year 2020/2021 CIP budget for unallocated capital improvements. The department uses this budget to fund new multi-year projects or fully fund projects within the current fiscal year. New projects at or in excess of \$100,000 are presented to the PDC for consideration. Staff presents projects under \$100,000 to the PDC for information and discussion. Staff then transmits the PDC meeting minutes to the Board for information.

The following is a summary of projects expected to utilize the unallocated CIP budget for fiscal year 2020/2021 to date:

- 27 PDC-approved project totaling \$4,844,000
- 12 projects under \$100,000 totaling \$852,300

Various resources are available to move these projects forward. These include in-house staff, on-call consultant contracts, on-call site and marine improvement contracts, and annual contracts for supplies and materials. The Board approves these resources either through the annual budget process or as contracts that receive separate Board approval.

#### **BUDGET CHANGE AND SCHEDULE CHANGE**

#### SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$1,279,810

#### PORT POLICE 700 MHZ RADIO SYSTEM RE-BANDING PHASE I

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to increase the budget and to extend the schedule for the Port Police 700 MHz Radio System Re-Banding Phase I project.

The Information Technology Division recommends increasing the budget by \$200,000 and adding six (6) months to the project schedule due to delays in obtaining electrical services and extra installation costs to the Marine Exchange communications shelter.

#### SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$1,430,000

#### HARBOR BOULEVARD PARKWAY REMOVALS - 1ST STREET TO 3RD STREET PROJECT - NEW PROJECT

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to initiate a new project for the Harbor Boulevard Parkway Removals - 1st Street to 3rd Street Project along the eastern side of Harbor Boulevard.

Per an MOU approved by the Board of Harbor Commissioners on April 15, 2021, this project will serve as part of the Harbor Department's contribution to the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles' (HACLA) grant funded Harbor Boulevard Parkway Improvements Project. HACLA's project is located adjacent to the Harbor Boulevard Parkway on the Harbor Department's former rail right of way. HACLA's project will create an open space area with bike trail, community garden, and fitness stations for the Rancho San Pedro community. HACLA's project is an extension of the Port's existing Harbor Boulevard Parkway and will provide Rancho San Pedro residents improved access to the LA Waterfront.

The proposed project consists of site preparation for the larger HACLA project. Work includes removal of existing items such as rail, overhead contact system, fencing and curbs; and minimal site work.

The total project cost is \$1,430,000 and the project will be completed by December 15, 2021.

SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$875,000

#### INNER CABRILLO BEACH PARKING LOT - STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS - NEW PROJECT

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to initiate a new project to incorporate stormwater management Best Management Practices (BMP) in the Inner Cabrillo Beach parking lot in an effort to comply with Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (LARWQCB) requirements for stormwater discharge.

The proposed work includes constructing infiltration basins at existing catch basin locations and installing pervious pavement to mitigate a 0.75-inch rainstorm.

The total project cost is \$875,000 and the project will be completed by December 31, 2022.

#### SCHEDULE CHANGE

SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$146,000

#### **REAR BERTH 301 PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS - SCHEDULE CHANGE**

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to extend the Rear Berth 301 Pavement Improvements schedule by three months with no additional increase in the budget.

The Engineering Division recommends adding three months to the schedule to allow for delays in coordination of the design with the tenant and delivery delays of the test equipment. The updated completion of construction will be July 10, 2021.

SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$770,000

#### LIBERTY HILL PLAZA ATRIUM SKYLIGHT REPLACEMENT - SCHEDULE CHANGE

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to extend the Liberty Hill Plaza (LHP) atrium skylight replacement schedule by nine additional months with no additional increase in the budget.

The Construction & Maintenance Division recommends adding nine additional months to the schedule to allow for delays due in submitting the purchase order for Board of Harbor Commissions (Board) approval.

# BERTH 100 (CHINA SHIPPING) - WEST BASIN CONTAINER TERMINAL (WBCT), ADVANCE ELECTRICAL INFRASTRUCTURE DEMONSTRATION

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to extend the Berth 100 (China Shipping) -West Basin Container Terminal (WBCT), Advance Electrical Infrastructure Demonstration project by six months with no additional increase in the budget.

The Engineering Division recommends adding six months to the schedule to allow for delays incurred specifying a replacement Battery Energy Storage System.

#### BERTHS 218-220 YUSEN TERMINALS (YTI) LANDSIDE STOWAGE PIN RELOCATION

#### SUMMARY

Staff requests approval to extend the Berths 218-220 Landside Stowage Pin Relocation schedule by six additional months with no additional increase in the budget.

The Engineering Division recommends adding six additional months to the schedule to allow for delays due to additional time needed to complete the design.

#### SUBJECT ORIGINAL PROJECT COST \$205,000

#### BERTH 161-CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE (C&M) - NATURAL GAS LINE REPLACEMENT

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff requests approval to extend the schedule for the Berth 161 – Construction and Maintenance (C&M) – Natural Gas Line Replacement by seven months with no additional increase in the budget.

The Engineering Division recommends adding seven months to the schedule to allow for delays in completing construction due to reduced resources and material availability due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The new Construction Finish date will be December 31, 2021.
