

# SR 47 INTERCHANGE PROJECT

NIGHTTIME CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND I-110 OFF-RAMP  
AND NORTHBOUND I-110 ON-RAMP



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## WHAT:

Crews will fully close the southbound (SB) SR47 off-ramp to Harbor Boulevard, for three consecutive nights. Concurrently, the northbound (NB) I-110 on-ramp from Harbor Boulevard/Front Street will be closed for one night. These closures are necessary to allow crews to safely perform construction activities at these locations for the SR 47 Improvement Project.

In order to facilitate these closures, crews will fully close the southbound SR47 off-ramp and northbound I-110 on-ramp during nighttime hours. These closures are essential for the removal of existing drainage systems and to perform work installing temporary drainage systems.

**NB ON-RAMP NIGHTTIME FULL CLOSURE:**

## NB ON-RAMP CLOSURE DETOURS:

### A) TRAVELING NORTH ON FRONT STREET, **Detour A:**

- Continue north on Front Street
- Turn right on Pacific Avenue
- Turn left on northbound I-110 on-ramp at John S. Gibson Blvd. to access the freeway

### B) TRAVELING SOUTH ON HARBOR BOULEVARD, **Detour B:**

- Continue south on Harbor Boulevard
- Turn right on 1<sup>st</sup> Street
- Turn right on Gaffey Street
- Turn right on northbound I-110 on-ramp to access the freeway



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## SB OFF-RAMP CLOSURE DETOURS:

- C) TRAVELING SOUTH ON SR 47, **Detour C:**
- Continue south on SR 47 to north I-110
  - Exit John S. Gibson Blvd.
  - Turn right on Pacific Avenue
  - Turn left on Front St.  
Continue to Harbor Blvd.

The SR 47 Interchange Project will replace the existing southbound SR 47 off-ramp from the Vincent Thomas Bridge, currently on the south side, with a new off-ramp on the north side. Additional improvements include realigning the existing on-ramp to the northbound I-110 connector; modifying the northbound SR 47 off-ramp onto Harbor Boulevard; modifying the northbound SR 47 on-ramp onto the bridge toward Terminal Island; and improving local streets near the interchange.
