Subject: Alameda Corridor Southern Terminus Gap Closure Project

Response to the Notice of Intent to Recommend Award to Griffith Company

Mr. Shahrestani,

This letter regards the above referenced project and is written to inform the Port of Los Angeles of potential issues with Griffith Company's bid and 5-day post-bid documents, including their Good Faith Efforts (GFE).

Per the contract documents the stated DBE goal for the project was 16%; the bid submitted by Stacy and Witbeck, Inc. (SWI) did meet this goal. In reviewing Griffith's bid package, the stated DBE commitment totaled only 4.5%, significantly below the 16% goal.

As part of their GFE, and per Exhibit 15-H DBE Information – Good Faith Efforts (Part C), Contractors were required to identify specific scopes of work for DBE consideration. Griffith's bid documents, and 5-day post bid package show that Pile Driving was identified as a scope of work for DBE participation (see attached Griffith GFE Part C submittal). However, it appears that Griffith did not solicit a quote from Tipco Engineering, one of only a couple of DBE firms that perform pile driving within the Southern California market. When SWI performed its' search for CUCP-certified DBE firms, Tipco Engineering was identified (see attached sheet from SWI CUCP DBE database search).

Additionally, SWI has been informed that Tipco Engineering provided a quote to not only SWI but Griffith as well. If correct, then this leads to another concern in that Griffith did not list Tipco Engineering in Part 2 of Exhibit 12-B as required by the contract documents (see attached Griffith Exhibit 12-B, Part 2 listing). Exhibit 12-B Part 2 states *"In accordance with Title 49, Section 26 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Bidder shall [emphasis added] list all subcontractors who provide a quote or bid but **were not selected** to participate as a subcontractor on this project."*

Further, a comparison of Tipco's quote for pile driving to that of Forefront Deep Foundations (the non-DBE firm listed by Griffith for piledriving) shows that there was less than a 1% difference in pricing (see attached Griffith Exhibit 12-B Part 1, Forefront Deep Foundations quote and Tipco quote). When a non-DBE firm is selected instead of a DBE firm, a


presumption of non-discrimination is typically made when the premium cost to utilize a DBE is more than 10% of the low bid for the same scope of work. This percentage is a standard that has been used by many public works agencies as a metric for the listing of DBE's over non-DBE's, a point to which Griffith seems to acknowledge within its own GFE documents (see attached Griffith rejection of DBE and reasoning). Had Griffith listed Tipco Engineering for pile driving on the project their DBE commitment would have increased from 4.5% to roughly 7.2%, albeit still significantly less than the 16% goal.

SWI treats utilization goals seriously when pursuing projects, whether local, SBE, DBE, or other. We submit that our efforts help to achieve the intent of such goals for agencies and more importantly, small businesses, and, for this project, proved that the goal could be met.

SWI is raising these concerns to the Port of Los Angeles so that it can look into the matter further prior to issuing a Notice of Award to Griffith Company for the above referenced project.

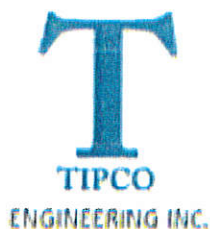

In verifying the status of prospective DBE subcontractors, Griffith Company reached out to Tipco at the time of bid regarding their DBE status. After the discussions with Tipco and review of the attached Caltrans certification summary, it was determined that Tipco is not certified for Work Code C4901 – Furnish and Drive Piling.
